

2016 Fall Semester - Admission guide for Undergraduate School

◆ Application Eligibility

A. Admission Requirements applicable for both new students and transfer students

- (1) A foreign student whose parents (both of them) are foreign nationals
 - (2) Either graduated or should be expected to graduate from high school
 - (3) Language Proficiency: Applicants must meet one of the following conditions:
 - a. Obtained an TOPIK level 3 or above
 - b. Passed Korean Language Test at Myongji University
 - c. Enrolled and completed level 3 Korean language course through 4 years university in Korea.
- ※ Admitted students without a TOPIK of level 3 or above are obliged to take Korean classes (6~9 credits) based on Korean levels.

B. Admission Requirements for transfer students (2nd year transfer)

- (1) Students who have completed one academic year and earned corresponding academic credits at another 4-year university
- (2) Students who have graduated from a 2-year college in China

C. Admission Requirements for transfer students (3rd year transfer)

- (1) Students who have completed two academic years and earned corresponding academic credits at another 4-year university
- (2) Students who have graduated or who are expected to graduate from 2~3 year college (3-year college and above for Chinese students)

◆ Compulsory Korean classes

Admitted students without a TOPIK of level 3 or above are obliged to take Korean classes (6~9 credits) based on Korean levels.

(4) Foreign Students scholarship : 40% reduction for the first semester (From the second semester, students with GPA of 4.0[A] or above – waiver of tuition fees, GPA of 3.5[B+] or above - 70% reduction, GPA of 3.0[B] or above - 50% reduction, GPA of 2.5[C+] or above 40% reduction, and GPA of 1.5[D+] or above 20% reduction) (Student must obtain more than 15 credit for each semester)

※ International students who hold TOPIK Level 4 or higher will be exempted from paying the admission fee of 880,000 KRW when entering the university.

◆ Dormitory

(1) Seoul campus Dormitory

Myongji University provides comfortable, state of the art rooms equipped with Internet access, auto door locks, private showers, air-conditioning and heated floors.

- Dormitory fee (16weeks): 4 Occupancy-KRW906,000, 2 Occupancy-KRW1,240,000(Meal not Included)

- Move-in Dates: Spring Semester (First week of March), Fall Semester (First week of September)

(2) Yongin campus Dormitory

Yongin Campus Dormitory is consisted of 5 buildings in total-MyongHyunGwan, MyongDukGwan, 3-Dong, 4-Dong, and 5-Dong. It may facilitate up to 1,866 residents and is equipped with a cafeteria, snack corner, convenient store, laundry room, gym and other various facilities.
